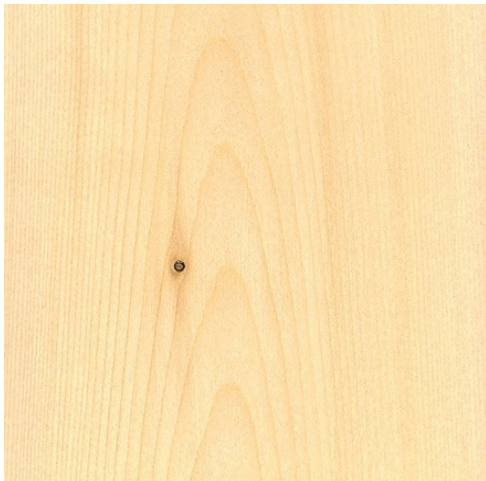


Alaskan Yellow Cedar: North West USA

<u>Other Name(s):</u>	Nootka Cypress
<u>Scientific Name:</u>	Cupressus nootkatensis
<u>Distribution:</u>	Northwest USA
<u>Average Dried Weight:</u>	495 kg/M3
<u>Durability:</u>	Durable

Seasoning:

- Dries fairly easily and without undue degrade.

Characteristics:

- A pale yellow-coloured wood, with a fine even texture, which is straight grained.
- It has no appreciable colour when dry.
- Very stable.
- Acid resistant.

Working Qualities:

- The timber is easily worked and finishes excellently.
- It can be glued, stained, polished and varnishes well.

Uses:

- High class joinery, boat building, cabinet work and veneers.

- Straight grain.

- Available in 50mm thickness only.
