

## Softwoods: Cedar – Yellow Alaskan



<b>Trade Name:</b>	Yellow Cedar
<b>Botanical Species:</b>	Chamaecyparis Spach, Cupressus nootkatensis Lamb
<b>Other Names:</b>	Pacific Coast or Alaska Yellow Cedar, Yellow Cyprus
<b>Country of Origin:</b>	Pacific Coast of North America
<b>Air Dry Density:</b>	500kgs/m <sup>3</sup>
<b>Durability:</b>	Durable
<b>Colour:</b>	Light
<b>Strength:</b>	6 (on a scale of 1 – 10)

### Seasoning:

- Dries fairly easily and without undue degrade.

### Characteristics:

- A pale yellow-coloured wood, with a fine even texture, which is straight grained.
- It has no appreciable colour when dry.
- Very stable.
- Acid resistant.

### Working Qualities:

- The timber is easily worked and finishes excellently.
- It can be glued, stained, polished and varnishes well.

### Uses:

- High class joinery, boat building, cabinet work and veneers.

### Product Attributes:

- Consistent yellow colour.
- Straight grain.
- Machines and turns very well.
- Veneers available.
