## Seasoning:

• Dries well with little degrade.

#### Characteristics:

- Fine, straight, close grain timber.
- The heartwood varies in colour from reddish-brown to rich red.
- The sapwood is yellow.
- Fine yellow, narrow brown coloured pith flecks and small gum pockets are a common feature.
- Sawn timber is graded on a one face heart basis.

# Working Qualities:

- Works easily.
- Machines and turns well.
- Very good polish finish.

# Uses:

• Fine furniture, high class joinery, boat interiors, musical instruments.

# Product Attributes:

- Attractive fine, close grain timber.
- Takes stain and polish very well.
- Veneers available.
- Good machining and turning capabilities.
- Colour reddish brown to rich red.

# Product Limitations

- Random widths.
- Face graded for heart content and then generally to a minimum of 75% to 80%.
- American grading rules apply.
- Fine, narrow brown coloured pith flecks and gum pockets are a common feature.
